How to Qualify for the Energy Tax Credit:

- A wood stove must be at least 75% efficient (HHV) to qualify for the credit.
- Available for tax years 2023-2032: You take the credit in the year that you install the qualifying wood stove.
- You cannot reduce your tax liability below zero, but you can carry any remaining credit forward to future years.





How to claim the Energy Tax Credit:

- You will claim the credit on your federal income tax return.
- **If you use software:** You will enter the credit in the "Residential Energy Credit" or "Alternative Energy Credit" Section.
- **If you file by mail:** Find the updated IRS form 5695 : "Biomass stoves."





The Energy Tax Credit covers 30% of These Costs:

- Wood Stove Purchase
- Installation Labor
- Chimney and Connector Pipe
- Hearth Pad

The 30% credit is capped at \$2,000: If your wood stove project costs a total of \$6,700: you will qualify for the maximum allowable credit of \$2,000.
